Q. Can one give NCA 4 for the dock doors

A. No. The tender requirement is to provide NCA 2 and above.

Q. Is pagination back to back

A. All pages/sheets of the bid document must be paginated and in a sequential format. Refer to tender document for detailed evaluation criteria.

Q. Apart from the MAF what else do we need to attach for the dock doors



- A. The requirements are clearly spelt out in the tender document. Refer to tender document for detailed requirements.
- Q. Is tax exemption also applicable to construction contracts (Civil works)
- **A**. Yes, All global fund tenders are tax exempt and KEMSA will facilitate Tax exemption. Refer to tender document for detailed tax exemption process.
- Q. Could you consider extending the closing date for supply of Male Condoms?
- **A.** The tender closing /opening date is hereby extended to 29th February, 2024. See attached addendum 1 dated 15th February, 2024
- Q. Is PPB registration a requirement for international bidders?
- A. Yes, PPB requirement is mandatory for all bidders.
- Q. Is the unit price for condoms per piece or pack?
- A. The unit of issue is per piece hence the price to be offered is for a piece
- Q. Do the international bidders require to have a local agent?
- A. The tenders are open to all and therefore, its at the discretion of the bidder to either bid directly or appoint a local agent to bid on their behalf.

- Q. How many servers are we to supply 25 or 3?

- Q. How many destinations are there for delivery

- Q. How do you prove production capability
- **A.** Production capability information is provided by the manufacturer and they are required to provide a statement on manufacturing capacity, in terms of quantity being produced either monthly or annually. If the supplier is not a manufacturer, they should obtain a statement on manufacturing capacity duly signed by the manufacturer. This is evaluated under post qualification criteria.



- Q. Does the tender for the supply of methadone dispensing cups require samples before tender opening.
- **A**. Yes, Properly labeled sample of each item quoted must be delivered to Kenya Medical Supplies Authority on or before closing date and time of the tender.
- Q. Now that PPB listing is a requirement, can one use a receipt to bid while awaiting the registration certificate.
- A. No, The required document is PPB listing certificate. Refer to the tender document.
- Q. If the submitted sample fails the criteria, is there room to correct since you cannot submit two samples at the same time.
- A. No, there is no room for correction.
- Q. Apart from supply of ICT items is my firm allowed to submit evidence of other goods supplied to other procuring entities e.g. safety wear.
- A. The goods should be of similar nature as detailed in the tender document.
- Q. On the tender for the supply of TB tools how many pages are required.
- A. The artwork shared are showing the no. of pages for every item. See attached links for artworks.
- Q. On the tender for GF ATM TB (RSSH)NFM 2023/2024 OIT 06, Kindly confirm if the tender bid bond amount stated under ITT 22.1 of USD 140,000.00 or 2,198,000.00 is correct.
- A. The correct bid bond amount in Dollar is USD 14,000.00 and not USD 140,000.00.
- Q. TENDER NO: GF ATM TB NFM 9RSSH)-2023/2024 OIT -07 SUPPLY OF WAREHOUSE EQUIPMET. We would like to request your office to extend the deadline for closure by another 2 weeks beyond the original closing date of 27th February, 2024
- A. Tender Closing/Opening date remains as scheduled.
